Type of Interaction

Content:

- One Way: The teacher presents to the class
- Two Way: The teacher presents to the class and the student can present back to the teacher
- All Way: The teacher presents to the class, the student presents to the class

Audio:

- One Way: The teacher talks to the class
- Two Way: The teacher talks to the class and the student can talk back to the teacher
- All Way: The teacher talks to the class, the students talk to the class

Camera:

- One Way: The students can see the teacher
- Two Way: The students can see the teacher, and the teacher can see the students
- All Way: Everyone can see everyone
